Dear Parents,

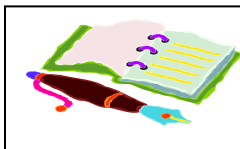
First of all 'Happy New Year'. I want to let you know some of the things happening in Year 4 this term.

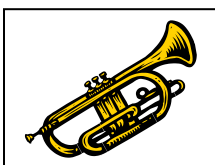
